
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

No record of corner being established found in County Surveyors Office.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the calculated corner position I set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 20" in ground and leveled flat spot on hillside and mounded earth to within 6" of cap from which:

A 19" White Fir bears S $58\frac{1}{2}$ ° W for 12.0 feet, scribed NW-SW 1/64 S35 BT. A 21" White Fir bears N $55\frac{1}{2}$ ° W for 50.9 feet, scribed NW-SW 1/64 S35 BT. Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54–3 and painted a red ring around

Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54–2 and 54–9.

Witness: Les Wilson

Used magnetic compass with $19\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E declination and measured to center of root crown on BT's with steel tape.
