
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position I set a $2" \times 30"$ iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 18" in ground and surrounded with stone to within 2" of cap from which:

A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears S 81½° E for 32.4 feet, scribed C-E-NW 1/64 S35\BT. A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears N 4° W for 50.3 feet, scribed C-E-NW 1/64 S35 By Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped

PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54-3 and painted a red ring around each BT.

Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-2 and 54-9.
