
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

None.


Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the calculated corner position I set a 2" \times 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked:

Set monument 15" in ground and surrounded with dirt and rocks to within 1" of cap from which:

A 17" Red Fir bears N 33° E for 43.5 feet, scribed C 1/4 S35 BT.
A 9" Red Fir bears N 45° W for 10.7 feet, scribed C 1/4 S35 BT.
Both BT's have a lower blaze scribed BT with a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed flush. Attached signs 54–3 and painted a red ring around each BT.

Set a steel fence post on property line by monument and attached signs 54-9.
