

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 30" long 25" in ground with 5" proj out of ground with surrounding rock mound and 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A fir 10 ins dia bears  $N53^{\circ}E$ , 23.4 ft dist marked 1/4S22 BT. A fir 14 ins dia bears  $S23^{\circ}W$ , 49.6 ft dist marked 1/4S21 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint, and a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
