Found 2½" brass cap on 1" iron pipe in small rock mound per survey no. 6-44-5.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Improved surrounding rock mound around corner monument and set a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached.

New bearing trees established: A tamarack 7 ins dia bears N69°W, 32.7 ft mkd T6SR44ES29 BT. A fir 14 ins dia bears N06°E, 32.3 ft mkd T6SR44ES28 BT. A fir 9 ins dia bears S44°E, 15.2 ft mkd T6SR44ES33 BT. A tamarack 8 ins dia bears S10°W, 77.4 ft mkd T6SR44ES32 BT.

Each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint and has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
