Found $2\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 1" iron pipe in small rock mound per survey no. 6-44-5.

A pine 32 ins dia bears $\rm N40^{O}E$, 40.9 ft with partially healed blaze. A sawed stump 30 ins dia bears $\rm S24^{O}E$, 23.7 ft with full scribes. A pine 34 ins dia bears $\rm N80^{O}W$, 61.6 ft with full scribes. No trace of 6 BT.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Improved surrounding rock mound around corner monument and set a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 attached.

New bearing trees established: A fir 14 ins dia bears SO9 W, 55.3 ft mkd T7SR44ES6 BT. A fir 16 ins dia bears S32 E, 33.2 ft mkd T7SR44ES5 BT.

Each original bearing tree and each new bearing tree has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 in band of red paint, additionally each new bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
