
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION


A 8 in diam white fir bears $N69^{\circ}$ E, 48.7 feet marked CN1/16 S27 BT A 12 in diam white fir bears $S84^{\circ}$ V 36.7 feet marked CN1/16 S27 BT

Set steel fence post approximately 5 feet Northerly with 54-2 sign and approximately 5 feet Easterly with 54-2 and 54-9 sign attached

I hereby certify this corner was re-established as hereon described on the date written above



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination, and distances to the new BTs are to the center of the tree. I placed a brass washer marked OPLS 644 by the BT blaze of new BTs.
