History of original corner establishment:

W.B. Barr, GLO, 1884

Set: A basalt rock, $13 \times 10 \times 9$ ins., 9 ins. in the ground marked 1/4 on the N side from which:

A fir 5 ins. diam., bears N 65° E 10 lks. (6.6 ft.) marked 1/4 S BT. A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S 40° W 120 lks. (79.2 ft.) marked 1/4 S BT.

Richard Kaiser, BLM 2004

Found: Nothing and proportioned the corner.

Set: A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top from which:

The marks XBO, on a basalt boulder, 3 x 3 x 1 1/2 ft high, bear N 86° E 5.3 ft.

A D. fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S 39 1/2° W 43.0 ft. marked 1/4 S15 BT.

Deposit a magnet In a white plastic case at the base of the stainless steel post.

Corner is located on toe of steep E. slope.

Description of corner evidence found:

Monument Found:

A stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., with a 3 1/4 in. brass cap showing 12 ins. above the ground and firmly set. The monument has a mound of rocks 3 ft. base to top.

Accessories Found:

A basalt boulder, 3 x 3 x 1 1/2 ft. high, bears N 86° E 5.3 ft. marked BXO. The marks face NE away from the cap. Measurements are taken to the X. (Kaiser)

A spruce (record D. fir), 20 ins. diam., bears S 31° W 43.0 ft. marked 1/4 S BT on a pitched over single blaze. (Record S 39 1/2° W) (Kaiser) This tree is alive and healthy.


Accessories Set:

A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 21 ins. in the ground bears S 13° E 7.2 ft.

A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 20 ins. in the ground bears S 1° W 6.4 ft. The rebar is set below a small rock outcrop.

A $5/8 \times 30$ in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 11 ins. in the ground bears N 86° W 6.7 ft. Two large rocks are set below the rebar.

An aluminum fence post with land survey monument sign bears S 2° E 5.5 ft.
