

## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

45° 01' 48.013" N 117° 09' 48.780" W +/- 5 Meters. **NAD 83** 



## Description of corner evidence found:

Monument Found:

A 3 1/4 in brass cap, flush with the ground and with a collar of stone.

Accessories Found:

No evidence of the NE BT was found. (Griffin)

A white fir, 12 ins. diam., bears \$ 70° W 19.1 ft. with a healed single blaze. This tree is healthy. Distance is measured to the face. (Record S 75° W)(Griffin)

## Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate corner:

Accessories Set:

A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 30 ins. in the ground bears

A boulder,  $5 \times 3 \times 4$  ft. high, bears S  $66^{\circ}$  E 6.9 ft. marked XBO.

A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. aluminum cap set 26 ins. in the ground bears S 42° E 6.1 ft.

A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 30 ins. in the ground bears S 28° W 4.9 ft. The rebar is just S of a large boulder.


A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 30 ins. in the ground bears N 52° W 5.2 ft.

An aluminum post with land survey monument sign bears \$ 32° E 6.7 ft.
