

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

45° 01' 34.613" N 117° 11' 13.369" W +/- 5 Meters. NAD 83



History of original corner establishment:

Philip Griffin, Cadastral Surveyor, 1994

Set: A stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap from which:

A spruce, 16 ins. diam., bears N 19 1/4° E 86 lks. (56.8 ft.) marked S 1/16 S23 BT.

A spruce, 20 ins. diam., bears N 6° W 73 lks. (48.2 ft.) marked S 1/16 S22 BT.

Deposit a white "deep-1" magnetic marker at base of stainless steel post.

Description of corner evidence found:

Monument Found:

A stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., with a 3 1/4 in. brass cap showing 6 ins. above ground firmly set. A stone mound 4 ft. base to top surrounds the cap.

Accessories Found:

A spruce, 18 ins. diam., bears N 21° E 57.5 ft. marked S 1/16 S23 BT on an open single blaze. This tree is alive and healthy. (Record N 19 1/4° E 56.8 ft.) (Griffin)

A spruce, 22 ins. diam., bears N 4° W 48.2 ft. marked S 1/16 S22 BT on an open single blaze. The tree is alive and healthy. (Record N 6° W) (Griffin)

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate corner:



Accessories Set:

A 5/8 x 30 in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 20 ins. in the ground bears S 20° E 5.6 ft.

A $5/8 \times 30$ in. rebar with 2 in. aluminum cap set 24 ins. in the ground bears S 71° W 7.3 ft.

An aluminum post with land survey monument sign bears N 50° E 5.4 ft.
