

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

45° 01' 21.324" N 117° 11' 18.529" W +/- 5 Meters. NAD 83



History of original corner establishment:

W.B. Barr, GLO, 1884

Set: A granite rock, 12 x 12 x 4 ins. 8 ins. in the ground marked with 2 notches on the S and E edges from which:

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N 88° E 48 lks. (31.7 ft.) marked T6S R45E S23 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S 37° E 58 lks. (38.3 ft.) marked T6S R45E S26 BT.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S 53° W 50 lks. (33.0 ft.) marked T6S R45E S27 BT.

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N 12° W 67 lks. (44.2 ft.) marked T6S R45E S22 BT.

Lester E. Fischer, BLM 1974

Found: The original granite stone, 12 x 12 x 6 ins. firmly set 3 ins. in the ground marked with 2 grooves on S and E faces from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A root hole, bears N 88° E 48 lks. (31.7 ft.) dist., with a down and decayed fir alongside, 5 ins. diam., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on an open decayed blaze.

A white fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S 53° W 50 lks. (33.0 ft.) with a healed blaze.

Set: An iron post, 28 ins. long 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap from which new bearing trees:

A subalpine fir, 9 ins. diam., bears N 67° E 42 lks. (27.7 ft.) marked T6S R45E S23 BT.

A western larch, 7 ins. diam., bears S 33 1/2° E 81 lks. (53.5 ft.) marked T6S R45E S26 BT.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N 85° W 64 lks. (42.2 ft.) marked T6 S R45 E S22 BT.

Bury corner stone alongside iron post.

Philip Griffin, BLM, 1994

Found: An iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap from which:

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S 51 1/2° W 47 lks. (31.0 ft.) with a healed blaze. ((Record S 53° W 50 lks. (33.0 ft.)) (Original)

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N 64 1/2° E 42 lks. (27.7 ft.) with fragmentary scribe marks on partially healed blaze. (Record N 67° E) (Fischer)

A larch, 8 ins. diam., bears \$ 37° E 86 lks. (56.8 ft.) with a healed blaze. ((Record \$ 33 1/2° E 81 lks. (53.5 ft.)) (Fischer)

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N 89° W 59 lks. (38.9 ft.) with a healed blaze. ((Record N 85° W 64 lks. (42.2 ft.)) (Fischer)

A steel fence post is alongside the iron post. The corner is located on a steep spur, sloping N.
