

IN 1881, E.P. MCCORNACK ESTABLISHED THE WEST LINE OF T.7S. R.38E. UNDER GLO. CONTRACT NO. 398.

IN 1881, W.B. BARR ESTABLISHED THE NORTH LINE OF SECTIONS 5 AND 6, T.75., R.38E. UNDER GLO. CONTRACT NO. 388.

IN 1882, W.R. GRADON SUBDIVIDED T.7 S., R.38 E. UNDER GLO. CONTRACT NO. 445.

IN 1981, SECTION 5 WAS SUBDIVIDED BY W. L. HANLEY (C.S. NO. 7-38-20) AND CORNERS WERE REMONUMENTED AS SHOWN A BOVE.

IN THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY CORNERS MONUMENTED BY THE BLM AND C.S. 7-38-20 ARE MAINTAINED BY SCRIBING NEW BEARING TREES, INSTALLING STEEL POSTS WITH APPROPRIATE SIGNS, NAILING APPROPRIATE SIGNS TO BEARING TREES. AND PAINTING 6" RED BANDS AROUND BEARING TREES AS NEEDED TO BRING THE MONUMENTATION TO U.S.F.S. STANDARD.
