
## RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

CORNER: CENTER-SOUTH 1/16 COR. SECTION 35, T. 7S., R. 38 E., W.M.

## PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED BY:

1) Baker County Survey No. 7-38-1 by Thomas Lagier, PE, dated October 20, 1971, filed January 19, 1972



**LAGIER'S 1971 DESCRIPTION:** Notation at corner: ANCIENT FENCE CORNER SW CORNER OF NW1/4 OF SE1/4


**EVIDENCE FOUND:** The corner of long-established fences running North, East and West as accepted by Lagier. I accept the postion of the fence corner as the best available evidence of the 1/16 corner.

## DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

At the corner point, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached 2-1/2" aluminum cap 30" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown below.

## From which, I SET THE FOLLOWING REFERENCE POINTS:

- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.89°15'W., 20.38 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.89°54'19"W., 440.00 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING.



Used RTK GPS to measure the reference points. Bearings are based on Land Partition Plat No. P2020-01.
