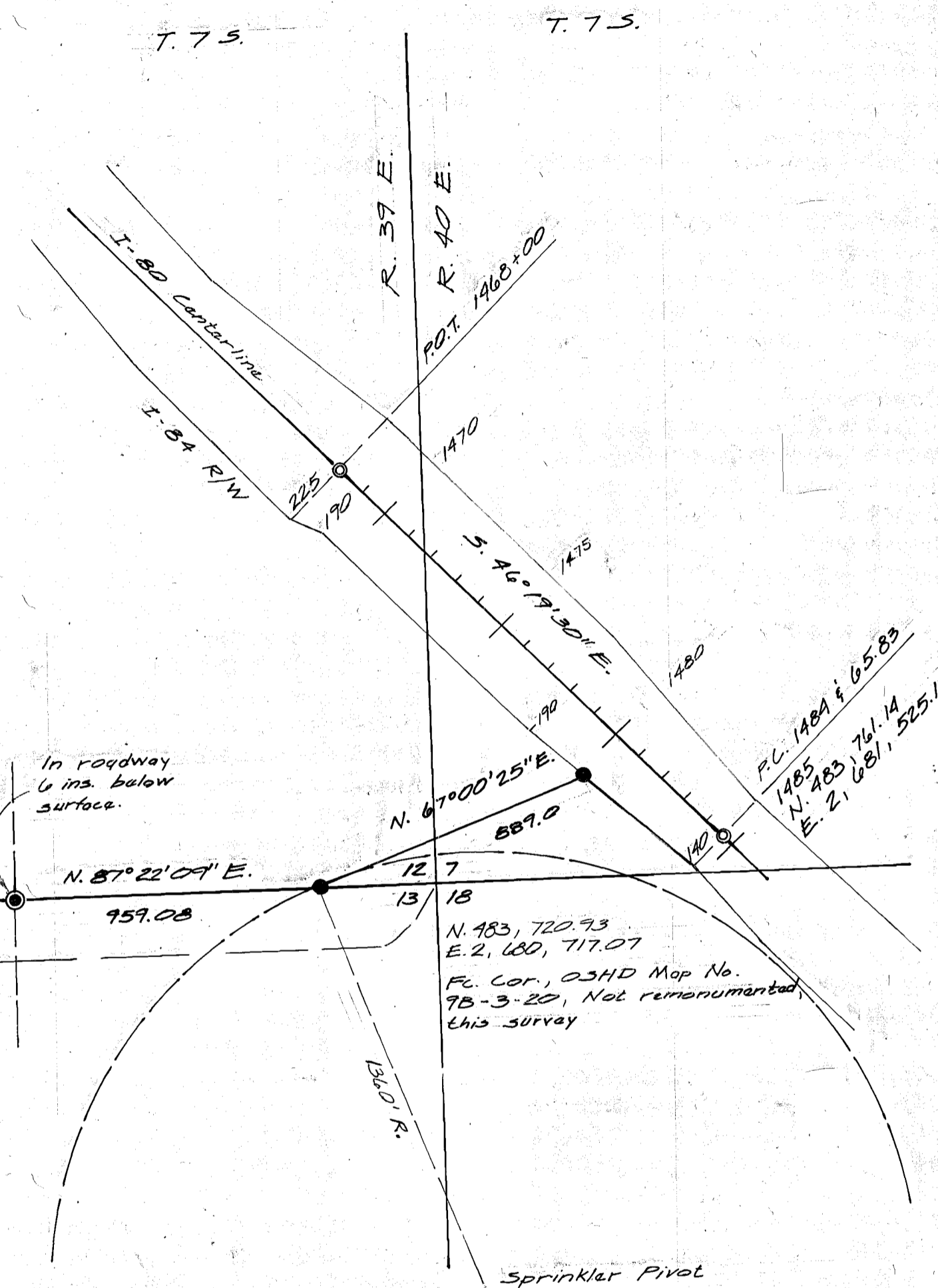
NARRATIVE

This survey for Ted Orr was made for the purpose of marking the proposed property boundary of a parcel to be segregated from the total farm area. The corner common to Secs. 12 and 13, T. 7 S., R. 39 E., and Secs 7 and 18, T. 7 S., R. 40 E., W.M. was originally marked by a wood post. The Oregon State Highway Department tied to a fence corner during their survey of the North Powder-Baker Section of the Old Oregon Trail Highway relocation. References to the fence corner, together with coordinates of the highway centerline are shown on their Drg. No. 9B-3-20 of September, 1967, revised September, 1970. The fence corner location is in a recently plowed field and is now obliterated. The highway data was then used to reestablish the corner point as it existed prior to 1967. I accept this fence corner as having perpetuated the original section corner location.

The original corner monument at the Northwest corner of Section 13 was also a wooden post. An ancient fence corners at this apparent section corner and was accepted as marking that original wood post position.

The lost quarter corner between Secs. 12 and 13 was reestablished by evenly proportioning between the East coordinates of the two section corners and in the old existing East-West fence line. I believe this is closer to the original position than a single proportionate method.

The East 1/16 corner between Secs. 12 and 13 was marked during the course of this survey with a brass-capped monument on a 1-inch galvanized pipe as a reference to the three relocated government corners described herein.
