NARRATIVE:

The purpose of this survey is to establish the proposed partition line creating two parcels from the total subject land.
 The land division closely follows existing fence lines except at the east and west ends of the traverse.
 Angle points along the boundary line are marked with steel rebars. Bearing and distance between points are computed and shown hereon and are basis for metes and bounds descriptions prepared for this purpose of land transfers.
