

ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION: Set post for 1/4 Sec corner in mound of Earth with charred stake pits trench as per instructions.

EVIDENCE FOUND: There is no remaining evidence of the original post. The corner is determined to be at the corner of long-established fences running North, East and South, which is the best available evidence of the original corner position.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

At the corner point, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached 2½ " aluminum cap 30" in the ground. Cap is marked as shown below.

From which, I SET THE FOLLOWING REFERENCE POINTS:

- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.89°07'E., 39.52 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING, set in an East-West fence
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears S.00°28'E., 25.59 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING, set in a North-South fence
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.57°00'W., 32.33 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING
- ► A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears N.00°39'E., 32.34 ft. with attached yellow plastic cap marked BENCHMARK SURVEYING, set in a North-South fence
