

At position by Survey, I set a 5/8" x 30"iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 11°19' West, a distance of 41.11 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.


A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 45°58' West, a distance of 10.71 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

Set steel fence post approx. 1 feet South.

Falls approx. 8 ft. East and 80 ft. South of fence corner to South, East and West bearing fence lines.
