

At position by Survey, I set a 5/8" x 30"iron pin, 22" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below and in a 4 foot diam. mound of earth and stone, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:


A 5/8" bolt in the center of an 4" irrigation riser marked TRAVIS PATTERN RAINWAY SPOKANE WA. bears South 9°56' West, a distance of 4.78 feet. A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 50°40' West, a distance of 24.50 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked N RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

Set steel fence post approx. 0.3 feet East.

Falls approx. 20 feet South of East/West bearing fence line.
