

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:


A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 82°12' West, a distance of 16.32 feet with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked S RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North 6°22' West, a distance of 14.22 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked N RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

Set steel fence post approx. 0.5 feet West.

Falls approx. 10 feet South of East/West bearing fence line.
