Set post for 1/4 sec. cor. in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, trench, as per instructions.

Corner is noted on ODOT strip map 5B-11-23. No description given.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found 2 stones well planted and extending 6" above ground. The Westerly stone is 4"x8" exposed and the Easterly stone is 2"x5" exposed and marked 1/4 on East. I do not fully excavate said stones.

The stones fall within 3 feet of surveyed position using the highway alignment from the Haines Highway as shown on said ODOT strip map. I accept them as a perpetuation of the original corner monument.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At center of stones position, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin between them, 24" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 45°59' East, a distance of 25.59 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NE RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 33°42' East, a distance of 22.40 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SE RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 36°29' West, a distance of 27.60 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 53°28' West, a distance of 11.82 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

An East/West fence line bears approx. 18 feet North and remnants of a North/South fence bears approx 7 feet West T7S R39E
