
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by David Thompson and Daniel Chaplin under GLO Contract Number 104, dated April 16th, 1864. Surveyor General Field Notes state:

Set post for 1/4 sec. cor. in mound of earth with charred stake, pits, trench, as per instructions.

In 1919 Ira Hoffman found a stone. Ira Hoffman Surey Book 34, Page 6 states: 39.63 chs. to fence + 63 lks N. to a stone. At 40.15 chs. +8 lks. West set a stake.



#### DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found an East/West fence line approx. 40 feet South of proportionate position. No stone found in the area.

# DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by Survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 29" in the ground, with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

### NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North  $51^{\circ}23$ ' East, a distance of 28.91 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NE RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South  $46^{\circ}29$ ' East, a distance of 47.45 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SE RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 46°01' West, a distance of 50.29 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North 61°17' West, a distance of 30.67 feet with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NW RP BGB SURVEY MARKER.
