

# DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 28" in the ground, with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

### NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North  $40^{\circ}56$ ' East, a distance of 22.70 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South  $57^{\circ}58$ ' East, a distance of 12.39 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER RP

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South  $77^{\circ}08$ ' West, a distance of 10.63 feet, with 1 1/2"

aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER RP A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears North  $45^{\circ}38$ ' West, a distance of 17.51 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER RP

Set steel fence post approx. 0.3 feet North

Falls approx. 4 feet North and 12 feet West of a fence corner to North/East/West bearing fence lines.


