

RECORD OF ORIGINAL CORNER AND SUBSEQUENT HISTORY:

The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, T. 7 S., R. 40 E., was originally established and described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 7 S., R. 40 E., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, executed by U.S. Deputy Surveyors David P. Thompson and Daniel Chaplin in 1864, under Contract Number 104.

Description: Set stone, 18x10x8 ins. For cor. to secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND AND DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Recovery Date: 9/23/2023

Description: The cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26 and 27, monumented with a basalt stone, 18x10x8 ins., lying loose on the ground, mkd. with 2 notches on an edge and 4 notches on an edge 90° to the 2-notch edge.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a collar of stone, 3 ft. diam., to the top of an aluminum cap as shown on this corner record.

from the aluminum post I add the following reference monuments


- A rebar, 30 ins. long, 5/8 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, bears S. 12°06'43" E., 100.05 ft. dist., with yellow plastic cap mkd. S&F LAND SERVICES.
- A rebar, 30 ins. long, 5/8 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, bears N. 47°20'37" W., 99.93 ft. dist., with yellow plastic cap mkd. S&F LAND SERVICES.

Basis of Bearings: Oregon North State Plane Coordinate System NAD83 2011 (Epoch 2010.0). All bearings for reference monuments that I set are in reference to said Oregon North State Plane. Distances shown hereon are ground distances, International Feet.

Buried the original basalt alongside the aluminum post.

Corner is in the corner of barbed wire fences, from which barbed wire fences extend S. and W. Corner is also located, W., 110 ft. dist., from a trail road, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 70° E. and N. 70° W.

Set a steel fence post, N. of the aluminum post, approximately 1 1/2 ft. dist.




Photo No. 2 of the basalt stone, mkd. with 2 notches on an edge.







Photo of the aluminum monument Diagram of the aluminum cap set in a collar of stone and in the corner of barbed wire fences.
