Description of corner evidence found:

Found a live 26" dia. P. Pine bearing S. $11\frac{1}{2}^{0}$ W. at 35.0 ft. dist. mkd. no scribe visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner:
Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum. pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " alum. cap set $2\frac{1}{4}$ " into the ground.
Constructed a 36" dia. stone mound around the monument. Cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram. Reestablished original corner from bearing and distance from found bearing tree.

From the corner point: (New BT)

A 10" dia. Tamarack bears N. 53° E. at 28.8 ft. dist., mkd. & S 6 BT.

Set a steel fence post h ft. South from the monument and attached a USFS 5h-9 sign. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around the bearing trees red. Attached I.D. washer and USFS 5h-9 and 5h-3 signs to bearing trees. Used $18\frac{1}{2}$ 0 declination on a staff compass for readings to bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees.

This corner was monumented to USFS specifications on August 6, 1987, Witnessed by Tom Fisk and Andy Marlette.
