Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum. pipe with a $2\frac{1}{3}$ " alum. cap 10" into the ground. Constructed a 36 in. dia. stone mound around the monument. The cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point:

P. Pine, 31 ins. dia., bears S. 56° E., at 156.9 ft. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S 19 BT.
A Stone, 5' x 3' x 2' bears N. 71° W., at 33.9 ft. dist., mkd X.

Set a steel fence post 4 ft. S. and set another post 4 ft. to the E. from the monument and attached a USFS 54-9 and 54-2 signs. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around the tearing trees red. Attached I.D. washer and USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to bearing trees. Used $18\frac{10}{2}$ declination on a staff compass for readings to bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the tree.
