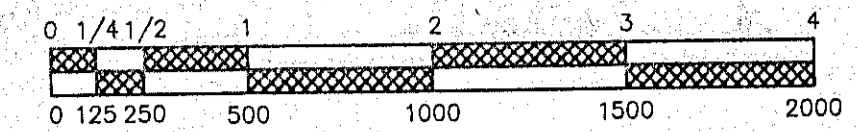
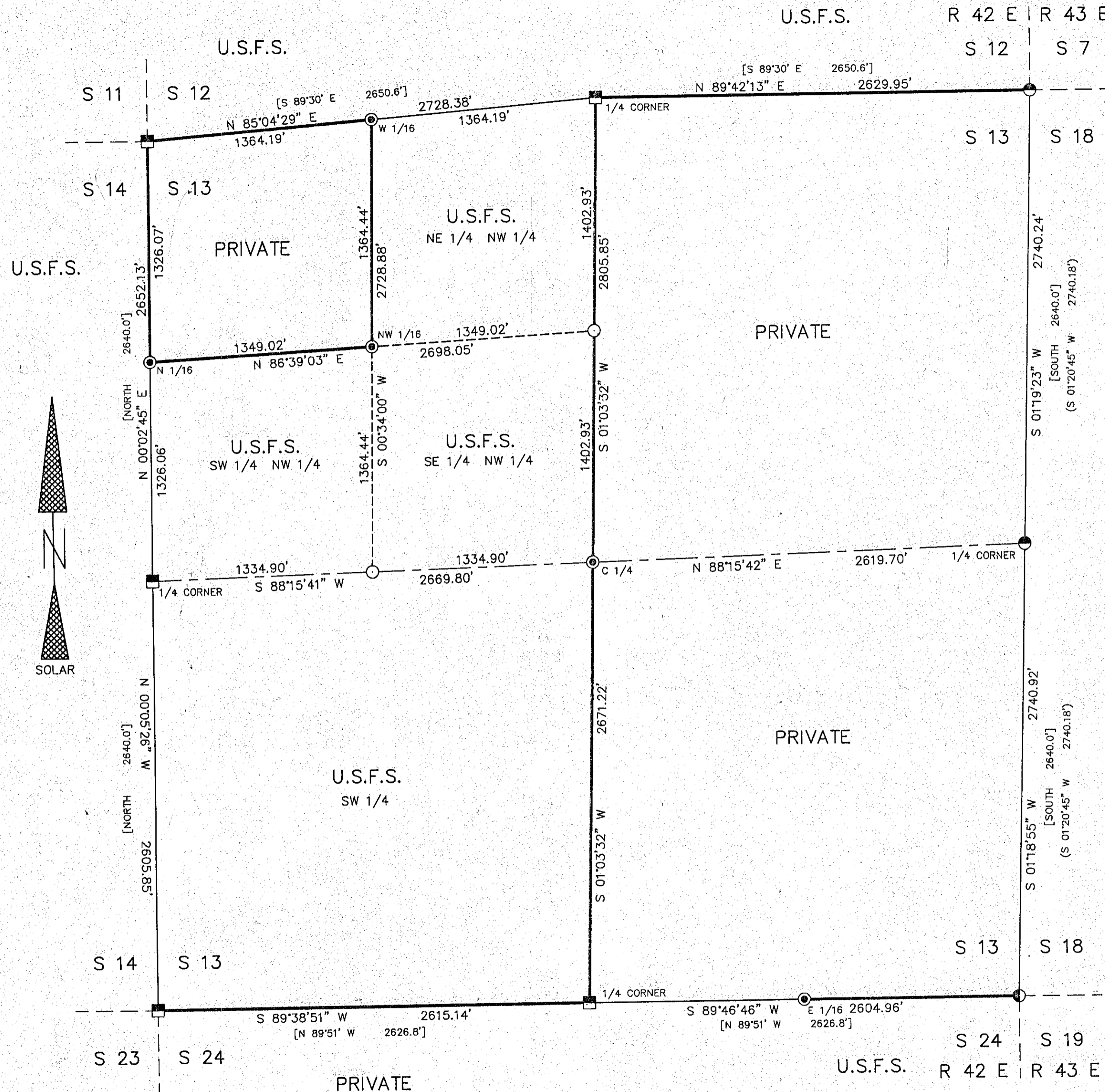


CLOVER CREEK CADASTRAL SURVEY

SURVEY NARRATIVE

BASIS OF BEARING WAS A SOLAR OBSERVATION TAKEN ON 9/27/1990, AT A POINT 907 FEET SOUTH AND 442 FEET WEST OF THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SAID SECTION 13.

THIS SURVEY REPRESENTS A RECORD OF THE PARTIAL RETRACEMENT AND/OR SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 13, T 7 S, R 42 E, W.M., BAKER COUNTY, OREGON.

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR, WALLOWA-WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST, BAKER CITY, OREGON.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO DETERMINE THE BOUNDARY LINES BETWEEN THE PRIVATE AND PUBLIC LAND ADMINISTERED BY THE U.S. FOREST SERVICE IN SECTION 13 AND TO POST TO STANDARD THOSE BOUNDARIES.

THE PROCEDURES USED IN THIS SURVEY WERE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS, THE 1973 B-L-M MANUAL AND STATE LAW, RESULTING IN AN ERROR OF CLOSURE OF 1 AND 5000 OR BETTER.

THE EQUIPMENT USED ON THIS SURVEY IS KEEP ADJUSTED AND STANDARDIZED. WE USED A 2" GEODIMETER 440 TOTAL STATION AND LEAP FROGGED A COMPLETE TRAVERSING SET UP AT EACH TRAVERSE STATION OR CONTROLLING CORNER.

LOST OR OBLITERATED CORNERS WERE REESTABLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE B-L-M MANUAL, A COMPLETE DESCRIPTION OF THE CORNERS FOUND, SET OR REESTABLISHED CAN BE FOUND ON PAGE TWO OF THIS RECORD OF SURVEY.
