
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set by intersection a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with $3\frac{1}{4}$ " aluminum cap 26" in ground in mound of stone, marked:

Bearing trees:

10" penderosa pine - S80'W - 54.0 ft. - scribed "MS 867 S24" in

upper blaze and "BT" and brass tag stamped RLS 1664 in lower blaze.

10" porderosa pine - S01½°E - 42.8 ft. - scribed "MS 867 S19" in upper blaze and "BT" and brass tag stamped RLS 1664 in lower blaze. Compass declination 20° East

I set steel fence post with USFS Attention sign at corner, placed USFS 54-8 signs on all bearing trees and painted red band on smoothed bark at breast height on all bearing trees.
