Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum. pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " alum. cap 26" into the ground. Constructed a 36" stone mound around the monument. The cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram. From the corner point:

A 7" dia. Western Larch bears S. 7° W. at 17.7 ft. dist. mkd. X BT. A 15" dia. Western Larch bears S. 77° W. at 58.4 ft. dist. mkd. X BT.

The WC was set N. 81° 27' 26" W., 640.16 ft. from the true corner point and on the line between lot 1 and lot 2.

Set a steel fence post 4' W. from the monument and attached a USFS 54-9 sign. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around the bearing trees red. I.D. washers were nailed between the scribed B and T of the new bearing trees. The washers are 3/4" in diameter and made of brass with PLS 1206 stamped on one side. Attached USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to bearing trees. Used $18\frac{1}{2}$ 0 declination on a staff compass for readings to bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees.

This corner was monumented to USFS specifications on August 3, 1987, witnessed by Tom Fisk and Larry McBroom.
