Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" alum. pipe with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " alum. cap 12" into the ground. Constructed a 36" dia. stone mound around the monument. The cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram. From the corner point:

A Ponderosa Pine, 11 ins. dia., bears N. 38° E., at 31.8 ft. dist,, mkd. N 1/16 S 17 BT.
A Ponderosa Pine, 28 ins. dia., bears S. 67° W., at 108.9 ft. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S 18 BT.

Set a steel fence post 5 ft. to the South and 5 ft. to the East and attached two 54-2 and one 54-9 signs. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around the bearing trees red. I.D. washers were nailed between the scribed B and T of the new bearing trees. The washers are 3/4" in diameter and made of brass with PLS 1206 stamped on one side. Attached USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing trees. Used $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ 0 declination on a staff compass for readings to the bearing trees. Used a steel tape to measure to a nail set in the side of the trees.

This corner was monumented by proportionate methods to USFS specifications on September 10, 1986, witnessed by Tom Fisk, Larry McBroom and Wade Stone.
