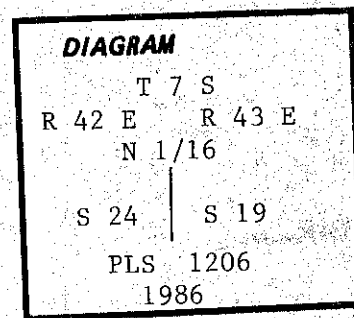


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

None, corner is established this survey.



Description of corner evidence found:

None.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½ in. x 30 in. alum. pipe with a 2½ in. alum cap 10 ins. into the ground. Constructed a 36 in. diam. stone mound around the monument. The cap is marked as shown in the corner diagram.

From the corner point:

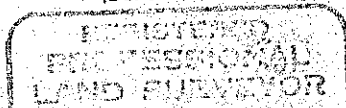
A Ponderosa pine, 31 ins. diam., bears S. 56° E., 156.9 ft. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S 19 BT.
A 5 ft. x 3 ft. x 2 ft. stone bears N. 71° W., 33.9 ft. dist., mkd X BO on South face.

Set a steel fence post 4 ft. South and a steel fence post 4 ft. East of the monument and attached a USFS 54-9 and a 54-2 sign. Attached USFS 54-9 and 54-3 signs to the bearing tree. Painted the face of the blaze and a 6 in. band around the bearing tree and the X BO on the bearing object red. Attached a ¾ in. brass washer mkd. PLS 1206 to the bearing tree between the B and T scribes at base of BT. Used a steel tape and staff compass with 18½° declination for measurements to bearing tree and the bearing object.

This corner was monumented to USFS specifications on Dec. 22, 1986, witnessed by Tom Fisk and Larry McBroom.
