A boulder, 3 ft. x 2 ft. x 1 ft. bears N. 38° F. 45.0 ft. dist., mkd. X BO on the top

A boulder, 3 ft. \times 2 ft. \times 1 ft. bears N. 38° E., 45.9 ft. dist., mkd. X BO on top of the East end.
