- The Wallowa-Whitman National Forest will resurvey Sections 16, 17, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34, and 35. As a part of the resurvey, all of PLS 1051's proportioned monuments will be tied and then buried in place. These positions will be shown in relationship to the new corner positions on the plat of survey. The bearing trees established by PLS 1051 will be used if possible, otherwise they will be obliterated.
- In addition to resurveying the above named sections affected by the recovery of original GLO corners, the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest will also resurvey Sections 25 and 36. This is necessary due to the procedures used in proportioning missing corners and subdividing the sections appear to not meet established practices. Again as part of the resurvey all of PLS 1051's proportioned monuments will be tied, buried in place, and referenced on the new plat.

## Agreement Statement

It is agreed that resolution will consist of cancelling the above named surveys conducted by PLS 1051, and the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest will conduct resurveys of this work.
