From which a fir 6 ins. diam. bears \$70°W, 34 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT. A fir 18 ins. diam. bears N45°E, 20 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."

Description of corner evidence found:

Found set 12 X 10 X 8 inch basalt stone, clearly marked 1/4 on north face. From which a rotten and burnt 30" fir stump bears N45°E, 13.5 ft. Southwest bearing trees falls in skid area and no trace could be found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At center of the above stone, set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized S17
pipe and brass cap marked: 1/4-1Set pipe 24" in the ground and mound of stone around to S20
cap. Buried marked stone alongside. OR PLS 1051
From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: 1982
A 9" Fir bears N40°E, 16.4 ft. scribed 1/4 S17 BT. A 16"

red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051
on the bearing trees. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.
