Found no trace of record stone or bearing trees. Corner falls near a road and logged area.

Set pipe 20" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

An 18" Pine bears N30°E, 11.0 ft. scribed 1/4 S22 BT.

An 18" Pine bears S65°W, 76.6 ft. scribed 1/4 S21 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the bearing trees. Placed a 54-4 on a steel fence post 5 north of the corner.
