## History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally established under G. L. O. contract number 503, by W. B. Barr, during August 11, 1884. Surveyor General's notes state: Set basalt rock 12 X 10 X 5 ins., 8 inches in ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on the N. side. From which a fir 4 ins. diam. bears N80°E, 101 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT. A fir 4 ins. diam. bears S12°W, 7 1ks. dist. marked 1/4S BT."

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record stone or bearing trees. Surveyed point is about 4 chains west of Eagle Creek and not 4.5 chains east as stated in the notes. Both sides of the creek were searched for the original corner.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe and cap marked:

Set pipe 24" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 10" Tamarack bears N26°E, 79.5 ft. scribed 1/4 S21 BT.

An 11" Fir bears S26°E, 17.9 ft. scribed 1/4 S28 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the bearing trees. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' south of the corner.
