Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and 1/4 S26 -- S25 brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground and mound of stone around to OR PLS 1051

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 14" Pine bears \$23°E, 64.5 ft. scribed 1/4 \$25 BT.
A 16" Fir bears N59°W, 24.5 ft. scribed 1/4 \$26 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4 and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the bearing trees. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north and placed 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' south of the corner.
