## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2" aluminum pipe 31" long buried 27" in ground with 4" proj. from ground with surrounding rock mound and 6' steel fence post alongside with sign 54-9 attached. Buried rebar alongside.

Aluminum cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A fir 14 ins dia bears  ${\rm N35}^{\rm O}{\rm E}$ , 15.1 ft marked CEW1/64S6 BT. A tamarack 11 ins dia bears  ${\rm N26}^{\rm O}{\rm W}$ , 45.8 ft marked CEW1/64S6 BT.

Each new bearing tree has a brass washer marked PLS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze and has signs 54-3 and 54-9 attached below a 6 inch band of red paint.
