
Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 21/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, with brass cap.

A pine, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 571/4° W., 451/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks on partially healed blaze.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 31/4° W., 421/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks on partially healed blaze

Aluminum cap stamped by Barbour, PLS 1051, bears S. 77°33'00" W., 0.050 chs. dist.



Found a 2½ ins. diam. steel pipe with a 3¼ ins. diam. brass cap, mkd. as shown, firmly set, flush with ground,

From the recovered monument I find the bearing trees mkd. by Barbour

A pine snag, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 57% W., 30.0 ft. dist., with visible scribe on open blaze.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., dead & down, bears N. 31/4° W., 28.1 ft. dist., with visible scribe on open blaze.

Found guard post 5 ft. South of recovered monument with Land Survey Monument (54-9) sign.

Found Barbour cap, 3.3 ft.; S. 771/2° W. from recovered monument.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

New bearing trees

A Douglas fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 36° E., 28.5 ft. dist., mkd. X BT, on double blaze, with washer on side center.

A Douglas fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 80° E., 24.3 ft. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S34 BT, with washer on side center.




