

Found a 3½ ins. diam. brass cap on a 2½ ins. diam. steel post, firmly set, flush with ground, mkd. as shown.

New accessories

A silver DEEP-1 magnet, bears N. 21 ½° E., 11.6 ft. dist., buried 12 ins. in the ground. A blue DEEP-1 magnet, bears S. 40½° W., 14.7 ft. dist., buried 12 ins. in the ground.

Set a guard post 5 ft. from recovered monument with Land Survey Monument (54-9) sign.


