Aluminum cap stamped by Barbour, PLS 1051, bears S. $8^{\circ}11'00''$ W., 0.155 chs. dist. I bury this monument in place.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears S. 71 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E., 36.0 ft. dist., with healed blaze.

A pine, 18 ins. diam., alive and healthy, bears N. 45 $\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 36.6 ft. dist., with healed blaze.




