ORIGINAL DESCRIPTION:

Set granite boulder 17x11x5 ins, 12 inches in ground for corner to Sec 14, 15, 22, 23 marked with 3 notches on the south and 2 notches on the east edges.

A pine 18" diam bears N81°E, 95 lks dist marked T7SR45ES14BT.

A pine 48" diam bears N23°W, 130 lks dist marked T7SR45ES15BT.

A pine 22" diam bears S15°W, 82 lks dist marked T7SR45ES22BT.

A pine 14" diam bears S55°E, 140 lks dist marked T7SR45ES23BT.

GARRISON'S DESCRIPTION:

The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees: A pine, 33" diam., bears S.15°W., 82 lks. dist., with scribe marks 45 S visible on partially healed blaze.

At corner point: Set an iron post, 28" long, 2½" diam., 24" in the ground, with brass cap mkd. From which new bearing trees:

A white fir, 25" diam., bears N.14°E., 16 lks dist. mkd. T7S R45E S14 BT.

A pine, 32" diam., bears S.45¼°E., 168 lks dist. mkd. T7S R45E S23 BT.

A pine, 18" diam., bears N.653/4°W., 204 lks dist. mkd. T7S R45E S15 BT.

Corner is located on E. edge of Pine Creek Road, bears N.30°W and S.30°E.

BARBOUR'S DESCRIPTION:

Found Corner (BLM Brass Cap)

EVIDENCE FOUND: I search for but do not find the iron pipe and brass cap. Monument most likely destroyed by road maintenance activities. Found 4 bearing trees with healed blazes.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS AND ACCESSORIES SET AND METHODS USED:

At the best fit of distances from found bearing trees, I set a $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 24" iron rod with attached 3¼" aluminum cap 36" in the ground, 12" into bedrock. Cap marked as shown. Monument lies in the ditch on the east side of State Highway 413.

From which, GARRISON'S BEARING TREES:

- ► A white fir, 43" dbh, bears N.21°E., 10.53 ft., with a healed blaze in good condition.
- ► A ponderosa pine, 40" dbh, bears S.36°E., 110.27 ft., with a healed blaze in good condition.
- ► A ponderosa pine, 36" dbh, bears S.24°W., 54.11 ft., with a healed blaze in poor condition.
- ► A ponderosa pine, 32" dbh, bears N.57°E., 134.11 ft., with a healed blaze in good condition.

Also from which, I SET NEW REFERENCE MONUMENTS:

- ► A 5/8" x 24" iron rod, bears S.82°W., 38.36 ft., with attached 2" aluminum cap marked RM 2 2023 PLS 91693. Painted a 6 inch red band around each bearing tree, and also painted blazes red and attached USFS 54-3 and 54-9 signs as needed. Distances measured with total station. Bearings measured with a handheld compass with 14° East declination.
