Description of corner evidence found:

A rotten pine with visible ancient axe work bears S  $73^{\circ}$  W, 97.7 ft (148 lks). No visible scribes.

A basalt stone 12x11x8 inches with identifiable chisle work.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe 31 ins long 27 ins in the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 ft steel fence post 4 ft West with a sign 54-4 attached.
