Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe 26 ins in the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 ft steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-4 and 2 signs 54-2 attached. Buried the original stone alongside.
