
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inch brass cap on a 2 inch iron pipe 31 ins long 8 ins below the road surface with a 6 foot steel fence post 4 feet South with a sign 54-2 and 54-9 attached and a  $4! \times 4" \times 6$  foot treated wood post 25.8 feet west with a sign 54-2 and 54-5 attached.

Brass cap marked thus:

New bearing trees: A pine 8 ins diam bears N 14° E., 70.0 ft dist marked CE 1/16 S 15 BT A pine 6 ins diam bears West, 31.1 ft dist marked CE 1/16 S 15 BT

Each new bearing tree has a sign 54-3 attached below a band of red paint and has a brass washer marked LS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
