



Set a 2½ inch brass cap on a 2 in. iron pipe 31 ins. long 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 ft. steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 and 2 signs 54-2 attached.

New bearing trees:
A pine 20 ins. diam. bears N 21° E., 152.4 ft. dist. mkd. CS 1/16 S 23 BT

A pine 6 ins. diam. bears N 71° W., 131.8 ft. dist. mkd. DS 1/16 S 23 BT

Each new bearing tree has a sign 54-3 attached below a red band of paint and has a brass washer marked LS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
