Description of corner evidence found:

A fence corner bears S 48° W, 55.5 ft. dist. from which the fence runs north and east.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2½ in. brass cap on a 2 in. iron pipe 31 ins. long 28 ins. in the ground with a surrounding rock mound and a 6 foot steel fence post alongside with a sign 54-9 and 2 signs 54-2 attached.

Brass cap marked thus: T 7 S R 46 E

New bearing trees:

A pine 12 ins. diam. bears S 19° W, 9.5 ft. dist. marked NE 1/16 S 27 BT  
A fir 6 ins. diam. bears S 57° E, 10.6 ft. dist. marked NE 1/16 S 27 BT

Each new bearing tree has a sign 54-3 attached below a band of red paint and has a brass washer marked LS 1639 nailed flush with BT blaze.
