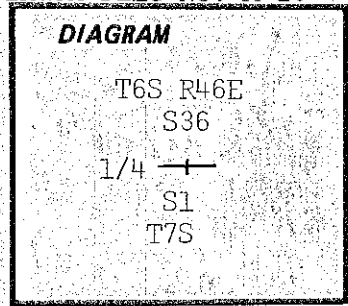


**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

Index File No. A-23

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner was originally established under G.L.O. contract No. 443 by W. B. Barr, during July of 1882. Surveyors General's notes state: "Set basalt rock 12 x 10 x 10 ins. 8 inches in ground for 1/4 sec. corner marked 1/4 on the North side, from which: A pine 10 in. diam. bears S20°E, 120 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S. BT. A pine 10 in. diam. bears N55°E, 100 lks. dist. marked 1/4 S. BT."

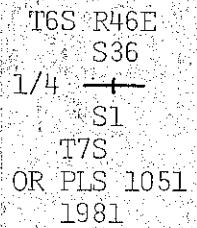


**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found no trace of record stone. Found 30" pine with two grown over blazes. Measured S55°W, 66.0 ft. from face. From here a 30" pine stump with visible T bears S19°E, 79.5 ft.

**Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

At measured point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked:  
Set pipe 22" in the ground and mound of stones around to cap. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:  
A 24" pine bears S30°E, 65.6 ft. scribed 1/4 S1 BT.  
Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3, 54-4, and brass washer stamped PLS 1051 on BT. Old BTs are signed. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' West of the corner.
