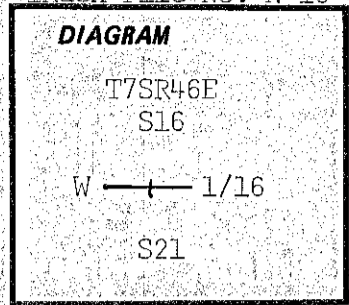


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At surveyed point set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 25" in the ground. No rock in the area. From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 14" pine bears S34°E., 21.8 ft. scribed W1/16S21 BT.

A 16" pine bears N08°E., 79.7 ft. scribed W1/16S16 BT.

Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-9s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Placed 54-2 and 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' north and 54-2 on a steel fence post 5' west of the corner.

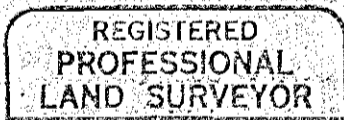
