From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:
A 24" pine, bears S35°E, 23.5 ft. scribed T7S R47E S1 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washer stamped PLS 1051 on the new BT. Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' east of the corner. Built mound of stone around to cap.
