## History of original corner establishment:

Blakeslee on August 4, 1901 Surveyor General's notes state: "Set a basalt stone 14 x 10 x 4 ins., 8 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 S on the N. face from which a fir 10 ins. in diam. bts N85°W, 50 lks. dist. marked 1/458 BT. and a fir 10 ins. in diam. brs. S85°W, 50 lks. dist. marked 1/458 BT.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record stone or BTs. Corner falls near main road in Little Elk Creek and was probably destroyed by road construction.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the center of surveyed point, set 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 16" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E:

A 10" Pine bears NO5°E., 77.9 ft. scribed 1/4 S8 BT.

A 12" Pine bears S28°E., 46.0 ft. scribed 1/4 S17 BT.

Painted blazes red and 6" red band around.

Placed 54-3s, 54-4s, and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on the BTs.

Placed 54-4 on a steel fence post 5' east of the corner.
